1. In what ways did your instructor make learning possible for you during the Fall 2021 semester?

Comments

I really like the part that he brings some social events and news to the class with what we learn together that can make me feel easier to understand.

Colin helped a lot by providing constructive examples of the content we were learning in lecture without burdening us with busy work. Overall this class was a refreshing way of reviewing the material and definitely helped me understand the material better.

He gave valuable lectures and open ended discussions that helped everyone grasp a good understanding of concepts and let opinions be heard from all sides concerning these concepts.

Colin did a very good job of connecting the material we were learning in class to current issues and events in politics. This allowed me to further understand the terms and topics of the course.

Colin did a great job facilitating meaningful conversations between students about concepts we discussed in lecture to deepen our understanding of the material. He was open to all viewpoints and willing to talk through topics that we found confusing. He made the topics interesting by incorporating lots of real world examples of what we were discussing in modern society.

He brought up current events at the beginning of recitation, explained what was happening, clarified statements if there was confusion, and provided questions that made us think about and reflect on readings that were important to course content.

The recitations were helpful for expanding on lecture concepts and giving me the opportunity to ask questions about concepts and going over explanations in a smaller group setting.

Colin was able to provide an open and respectful learning environment to express my viewpoints. Politics and discussion around it can often be a tense subject for many but I feel that Colin navigated through the topics well and allowed all sides to be noted and expressed without judgment.

Colin was very clear about expectations from the beginning of the semester. His syllabus was very detailed so we knew what readings we had to do and when. He encouraged us to really engage with the course content and draw connections between things we discussed in lecture and the real world. He was very easy to talk to and made people feel very comfortable speaking up and he encouraged us to do so. He was also very accessible outside of lessons. I always felt very comfortable going to see him in office hours and knew that I was going to leave understanding all the questions I had at the beginning.

Collin was a great asset whenever I had questions about source material or needed clarification about something that happened in lecture. I can recall several instances where complex wording was used in lecture and I was able to get a more clear and concise version in my recitation section. In addition, Colin made learning easier by always adding class discussions that allowed me to challenge my beliefs outside of merely the course curriculum but also in things that happen in everyday life.

I think Colin did a great job of stimulating class participation and connecting the things that we were learning about to current events in American politics in each recitation.

He stayed on topic and stayed consistent with the syllabus. He also often sent reminders about the weekly readings and other assignments throughout the semester.

He gave us a lot of opportunities to speak during class and vocalize our opinions. He was very respectful to what everyone had to say. He was always asking if anyone wanted to add anything to the discussion and having us talk to our classmates about certain topics to get ideas from others.

recitations were very good and he was good at keeping the conversation on track and asking good questions to keep us engaged with talking to our fellow classmates.

We met once a week on a schedule that was followed strictly. Colin also opened the recitation up to class discussions by giving us questions to talk to a partner with and about. We also discussed readings that were assigned for the class period which we would discuss in detail.

He did a great job highlighting the main points of the assigned readings at the beginning of class, then would take roughly the last half to have the students engage with him and each other to better understand the material. Great structure of the class – best I've seen from a TA. Personally, I rarely feel comfortable talking in class, but his discussions certainly helped to understand the material.

I think the supplemental readings are really helpful for the course as a whole, as well as the powerpoints paired with them.

I think Colin should keep the group discussion aspect. I also think he should continue to elaborate on current events to help students connect lecture content with daily life.

I think the opportunity for discussion of current events at the beginning of class should be kept as well as when students break into smaller groups and discuss questions with each other related to the material.

I like how Colin was always attempting to get people to speak. Personally, I didn't talk a whole lot during the section because I get shy and nervous talking in class sometimes, especially when I'm not super confident on the subject. Even though I didn't talk a lot, I liked getting to hear other student's opinions and thoughts and I also liked that Colin didn't just give us long lectures every class, he actually had us talking and engaging.

Assigning readings before the recitation section was always helpful. I could read it the same day before I would go to class and then we would discuss it in class in a way that was related to the main lecture. I also like how grading is based on participation which is one thing I think our class did not understand. There were a lot of class emails that went out for our recitation section but it could be a good idea to send personal ones to students so they can ask you individual questions. Just a suggestion though and overall I think the course was great!

Allow students to send their rough drafts of paper to you to review before the final due date (if it's not too much trouble).

Colin was very kind, welcoming, and encouraging towards his students. I appreciate the emphasis on group discussions. My only critiques are the software he used to leave commentary could only display a certain number of words (some of the commentary could not be read) and I think more interactive class activities (such as the circling of the shapes for gerrymandering) could improve the class dynamics.

Colin was always friendly and approachable. He made himself available for questions or discussions both before/after class and in office hours. He graded assignments fairly and provided good, constructive feedback. He created an open environment during class where students could freely express their differing opinions. I enjoyed the activities we would do during class such as creating flow charts or organizing how we would gerrymander districts. He seemed very knowledgeable on the subject of the course and seemed passionate about it. You could tell he wanted all of his students to succeed.

The recitation and its readings did not make me feel as though I was learning more in depth about the course material. This could just be the mix of students I ended up in, but I found the class really boring and not at all engaging despite Colin's efforts. I'm not sure if his efforts weren't enough or the students just weren't big chatters. Either way, even when people discussed and answered questions it didn't feel ultimately engaging for me.

I personally think Colin was a great teacher and I did like being in his recitation section. I feel like he did grade papers a little harshly, because I have always been really interested in writing and have never gotten below a B on any essay before this course. However, when Colin graded both of my papers in this course they were a lot lower than I was expecting, especially because I had multiple people edit and critique both papers before I submitted them. I felt like the comments he made were slightly vague and didn't really help me understand why exactly I got points off.

I really enjoyed this recitation section with Colin, the one thing I would try to do to better teach students and make them feel comfortable enough to participate in class discussions is to open up to them. Maybe talk a little bit before class starts, tell them that if they need to talk about anything or want to that they can. Reiterating the idea that they should be completely 100% safe to speak up during class.

This may be INCREDIBLY controversial for some introverted students, but I have a very hard time speaking in classes as I often feel that everyone already knows and has the same answer. With this though, I never mind when teachers call on me randomly to answer a question. Possibly doing this every now and then to encourage participation from those who don't speak up much could be useful.
